employU's Transition Youth Services Program provides self-advocacy training, career preparation training, and work experiences for students ages 14-22 that meet eligibility for special education services through either a 504 Plan or an Individualized Education Plan (IEP)

VOCATIONAL EVALUATIONS

A vocational evaluation assists students in identifying a career and/or educational path that is consistent with their aptitudes, interests, and abilities. We also identify reasonable accommodations, specific to the student's unique needs, which may assist them in achieving successful On the Job Training experiences.

EMPLOYMENT PREPARATION CLASS

employU's Employment Preparation Class consists of 20-hour sessions that include relationship building, goal setting, resume building, job search methods, application tips, and interviewing skills.

The Self-Advocacy Class is a two-part program designed to provide guidance on building a path to independence. Much of the program is spent on what is appropriate when on the job to help teach students the difference between work and social life. Role playing methods are used to develop conflict resolutions and decision making skills.

PAID COMMUNITY WORK-BASED EXPERIENCES

employU's Community Work-Based Experience program generates opportunities to gain real work experience. We partner with a variety of local businesses to offer different learning experiences for each student. When a student first enrolls in our program, an employU specialist meets with them one-on-one to develop a customized plan based on their interests, abilities, and availability.

INDUSTRY-BASED CAREER EXPLORATION

employU partners with a variety of industry-specific associations to offer students vocational training internship opportunities. Many industries - such as manufacturing, construction, hospitality, and more - are in great need of skilled employees and are willing to offer training and certification opportunities to build their labor force. By participating in these special programs, students develop specific job-related skills, can receive an OSHA 10 certification which teaches safe practices for highly skilled positions, and be ready to pursue a career path with little to no student loan debt after high school.

BY PARTICIPATING IN THIS EXPERIENCE STUDENTS WILL:


- Develop skills such as relationship building, goal setting, resume building, job search methods, application tips, and interviewing skills through **Work Readiness Training**.
